

Dog License Application

Sonoma County Animal Services



State and local laws require dogs four months of age to be vaccinated against rabies, one year after the primary vaccination, and every three years thereafter. Dogs must also be licensed each year. There is a discount if your dog has been altered (i.e. spayed or neutered, proof required). Senior citizens age 62 and over pay a discounted license fee for altered dogs. You must be at least 18 years of age to obtain a dog license in your name.

Fees: Residents of Unincorporated Sonoma County, City of Santa Rosa and Town of Windsor

- \$26.00 for altered dogs (proof required)
- \$13.00 for altered dogs of owners aged 62 and over
- \$100 for unaltered dogs
