



Sonoma County Animal Services Love Me, Fix Me Access Program Application

How to Qualify for a Reduced Fee

The Love Me, Fix Me Access program offers spay/neuter services to qualifying applicants for a cost of \$30 for cats and \$55 for dogs (includes dog license if applicable). To qualify for the program, you must be a resident of Sonoma County with a qualifying household income level. You may qualify by one of two (2) methods:

Method 1:

You or another person in your household is currently participating in one of the qualified assistance programs listed below:

- CalFresh/Food Stamps
- SonomaWorks/CalWorks/TANF
- WIC
- Free or Reduced Lunch
- Medi-Cal
- AT&T Lifeline

If available, please attach a copy of supporting documentation of the member of the household who participates in the qualifying program.

Method 2:

The combined income of all household members does not exceed the “very low income” limitations by household size as established by the California Department of Housing and Community Development for Sonoma County (<http://www.hcd.ca.gov/hpd/hrc/rep/state/incNote.html>).

If available, please attach a copy of any of the following documentation for members of your household to show your total household income:

- Prior year’s state, federal or tribal tax return (such as, California Resident Income Tax Return Form 540, or W-2 Income Form);
- Income statements or paycheck stubs for 3 consecutive months within the calendar year; or
- Statement of Benefits from Social Security, Veterans Administration, retirement/pension, unemployment, worker’s compensation or other official documentation.
