

EHV referrals

- ▶ The EHV referral working groups have completed all referrals to the Housing Authorities
 - ▶ Additional referrals may be needed if there is turn over in vouchers.
- ▶ Next Steps
 - ▶ The Referral working groups will continue to meet to check on participant progress and address barriers to getting clients housed.
 - ▶ A centralized housing location group has begun to meet to develop a landlord outreach and engagement strategy.

Resources for EHV

- ▶ Rapid Re-housing assistance:
 - ▶ West County Community Services: 6 deposits, 3 with supportive services
 - ▶ IFSN 10-15 deposits. Client must have done time in CA state prison
 - ▶ Reach for Home: 5 deposits
 - ▶ Catholic Charities: \$183,000
 - ▶ Eligible uses: Deposit, First month's rent, utility deposits, utility payments, moving costs, outreach to landlords
- ▶ EHV funds
 - ▶ Eligible uses: Deposit, holding fee, rental application fees
 - ▶ Upon special request only: \$500 LL incentives, \$500 moving costs, utility deposits, arrears
