Voluntary Reallocation

*The following projects voluntarily reduced their eligible funding amount in order to make additional renewal funding available for reallocation to new projects:

- Sonoma County Community Development Commission, Renewal Rental Assistance - Chronically Homeless Persons with Mental Illness- Full project reallocation of \$116,337
- Sonoma County Community Development Commission, Renewal Rental Assistance - Homeless with Chronic Health Problems- Full project reallocation of \$252,098
- Reach for Home, North County RRH – Reduced project from \$210,477 to \$86,539.00

The combined reallocated funding supports projects #13, #14, and #15 on the Priority Listing.

Consolidations

**As permitted in the 2021 Continuum of Care Competitions, the following projects applied for consolidation of grants this year:

1. The Sonoma County Community Development Commission applied for the following projects to be consolidated. Each project was submitted individually as required by the 2021 CoC NOFO:

- Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) Expansion
- HMIS Expansion 2019

Projects not rated

- Reach for Home North County RRH, was not scored due to lack of full Annual Performance Report (APR) submission and the agency has not yet begun serving clients.
- Sonoma County Community Development Commission’s Coordinated Entry Expansion Project, HMIS Expansion 2019, and Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) Expansion Project are mandated projects for the Sonoma County Continuum of Care.

Because these are mandated activities, these projects were not scored as part of the evaluation process.

Tier 1 and Tier 2

Due to a high amount of voluntary project reallocation, there are no projects that are straddling tiers. All projects, new and renewal, are placed into tier 1 and being recommended for full funding.

New Project Scoring Decision

Although New projects #16 and #17 numerically scored higher than all other projects listed on the priority list, the Sonoma County 2021 CoC Competition Evaluation Ad Hoc Committee recommended these projects be placed below renewing projects as they are expansions of existing renewals.
