If you will be receiving a lump sum payment and you would like to defer any or all of the lump sum payment into your 457(b) Deferred Compensation account with Nationwide, (either on a pre-tax basis or after-tax basis (Roth), please complete the <u>Accrual/Lump Sum Deferral Form</u> for a one-time deferral. This form will not supersede or replace any regular ongoing deferrals.

- Form submission deadline is the end of day Monday the last day of the pay period.
- Your lump sum payment will be subject to the following deductions:
  - Social Security and Medicare taxes totaling 7.65%\*
  - If you are a plan A, Legacy Employee, employee pension contributions, ranging from an estimated 10%-15% depending on your specific retirement enrollment coverage; and
  - Federal and State withholding taxes will be applied to any amount not deferred into your pre-tax 457 Plan.
