

I am writing to request your support for my appointment to the Local Agency Formation Commission as one of the two members to be appointed.

In 2021 I was elected, via special election, to fill a vacant seat on the Sonoma City Council and have already submitted my Candidate Intention statement for 2024. Previously, I served two terms on the Sonoma Valley Unified School District Board of Trustees. Currently, I am serving on multiple County committees, including Sonoma County Transportation & Regional Climate Protection Agency and Sonoma Clean Power.

The City of Sonoma has just received its first LAFCO approved MSR since 2006. The MSR made four recommendations about modifications to the City's SOI, one of which includes eliminating an "island". Further, there is continued discussion of annexation of the "Springs" area adjacent to the city limits. The City of Sonoma has not had membership on the commission and wishes to be more actively engaged at the regional level by filling a seat at LAFCO.
