- The Commission is the administrative body

Continued Policies Background

- Support goals and priorities of the Consolidated Plan (aka "ConPlan")
 - Affordable housing
 - Prevent, Reduce Homelessness
 - Non-Housing Community Development
- Annually reviewed and revised for upcoming fiscal year Action Plan
- Urban County beneficiaries
- LMIHAF Funds local program, targets homeless prevention and rapid rehousing countywide; up to \$250,000 allocated
