## 4. FY 2018-2019 City/Town CDBG Funding Proposals

- a) Staff Report Benjamin Wickham presented the staff report and responded to committee questions.
- b) Committee Discussion, Recommendations, and Contingencies Larry Zimmer, representing the City of Healdsburg expressed that he'd like to see the \$50,000 that staff recommended awarding to Foss Creek Pathway to another project given that awarding such a small amount would add complications to a high priority project. The committee asked questions of representatives from Habitat for Humanity and SAHA about their projects. The

Committee discussed potential ways to reallocate the \$50,000 that Healdsburg proposed go to a different project. Ultimately, the committee proposed \$15,000 for the City of Cotati, \$15,000 for the City of Rohnert Park and \$20,000 for Healdsburg.

David Kelley moved to approve the reallocation, Henry Mikus seconded, and the vote was:

The Committee discussed appropriate language for the contingency. Geoffrey Ross recommended deferring to staff for percent reduction.
