NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
COUNTY OF SONOMA ADVISORY REDISTRICTING COMMISSION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Advisory Redistricting Commission of the County of Sonoma on August 23, 2021 at 6:15 p.m. to consider the redistricting process. Every 10 years, local governments use data from the Census to redraw their district lines to reflect how local populations have changed. Redistricting determines which neighborhoods and communities are grouped together into a district for purposes of electing members to the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors. Community participation is strongly encouraged to ensure district lines respect neighborhoods, communities of interest, history and geographical elements. The public hearing will be an opportunity for members of the public to learn more about redistricting and to provide their input on where district lines should be drawn to best represent their community.

The August 23, 2021 public hearing will be facilitated virtually through Zoom. Members of the public can watch or listen to the meetings using one of the following methods:
