NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
COUNTY OF SONOMA BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO INTRODUCE AND ADOPT AN ORDINANCE FOR A NEW SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT MAP

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors on December 7, 2021 at 8:45 a.m. to introduce and adopt an ordinance for a new supervisorial district map. Every 10 years, local governments use data from the Census to redraw their district lines to reflect how local populations have changed. Redistricting determines which neighborhoods and communities are grouped together into a district for purposes of electing members to the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors. Community participation is strongly encouraged to ensure that district lines respect, to the extent practicable, the following qualities: geographic contiguity; minimal division of neighborhoods and other communities of interest; minimal division of cities; geographical boundaries; and geographic compactness.

The December 7, 2021 public hearing will be facilitated virtually through Zoom. Members of the public can watch or listen to the meetings by joining the virtual meeting on computer, tablet, or by phone. Meeting details will be posted on the County's Board of Supervisors meeting website at <https://sonoma-county.legistar.com/Calendar.aspx>.

Members of the public are encouraged to attend virtually but may attend in person with modified protocols. Seating will not be available in the Board Chambers for public participants. Members of the public may listen to the Board meeting in the Administration Building hall or outside the main entrance located at 575 Administration Drive, Santa Rosa, 95403. Limited socially-distanced seats will be available in the building hall and outdoors.

Spanish language interpretation will be available. Requests for interpretation in additional languages or for disability-related modification or accommodation may be arranged by emailing a request to redistricting2021@sonoma-county.org at least 72 hours prior to the meeting.

Public Comments may be made live during the meeting by joining the Zoom meeting using one of the methods above. All INTERESTED PERSONS ARE INVITED TO BE HEARD ON THESE MATTERS.
