



Southeast Santa Rosa

A *Portrait of Sonoma County* identifies as a priority area two tracts in Southeast Santa Rosa, Kawana Springs and Taylor Mountain, which rank eighty-first and eighty-ninth, respectively, on the human development index among the ninety-nine Sonoma County census tracts. Their low scores place Southeast Santa Rosa at high priority for intervention. Place-based efforts currently underway focus on strengthening educational systems, access to health services, and healthy food outlets.









